ELECTRONICS may be recycled at Recycle Center

These items may also be taken to the MUA Transfer Station located on Shunpike Road in Burleigh (first right after Home Depot). Call the MUA at 465-5004. There is a charge of \$10.00 for air conditioners and refrigerators or anything with freon.

Rules and regulations for the City of North Wildwood's Trash/Recycling Program are on the back.

Rules and Regulations for Trash/Recycling Program

CURBSIDE TRASH-MUST BE IN CONTAINERS WITH LIDS (eliminates trash being eaten by gulls and other creatures)

Trash may be placed in plastic bags; however, all trash must be placed in metal or plastic trash receptacles with lids at a **maximum size is 32 gal.container with weight limit of 50 lbs. per container**. Larger items must be bundled and placed curbside. Containers may not be placed at the curb before 5:00 p.m. on the day before your collection day and removed by 5:00 p.m. on the day of collection. Trash and recycles must be at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on appropriate collection days.

**NO ESTABLISHMENT MAY EXCEED 10 RECEPTACLES
OR THEIR EQUIVALENT AT ANY ONE COLLECTION**

RECYCLABLE INFORMATION

BOTTLES AND CANS (ITEMS CAN BE MIXED INTO A TRASH CONTAINER, BUT NOT IN PLASTIC BAGS):

- glass bottles and jars (all colors)
- household plastic container (i.e. detergent, cooking oil & bleach) #1 and #2 only
- aluminum cans
- tin plated steel cans (i.e. fruit, vegetable fish and pet foods)
- plastic soda bottles, water, milk jugs, detergent, bleach and cooking oil containers #1 and #2 only
- bi-metal cans (i.e. non-aluminum beverage cans)

Motor Oil and Cooking Oil will be accepted at the Trash and Recycling Center from Monday through Friday only between 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. In order to place the product into the tank, please visit our Public Works Facility across the street for assistance the empty containers they are kept in are then trash.

PAPER (ITEMS ARE TO BE BUNDLED OR PLACED IN BROWN PAPER BAGS):

- newspapers
- magazines
- junk mail
- cardboard

**CARDBOARD CANNOT BE USED
AS A TRASH CONTAINER**

**PLEASE DO NOT RECYCLE ITEMS WHICH ARE
CONTAMINATED WITH FOOD, ETC.**

PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO HOLD ANY RECYCLED ITEMS !!!

NOT RECYCLABLE:

- Food boxes, cereal boxes, beverage carriers, egg cartons, paper cups or plates and laminated paper, shoe boxes, gift boxes, coffee cups, are all considered trash. Pizza boxes are trash and need to be put in container.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE HANDLED IN THE APPROPRIATE MANNER:

- **BRANCHES** – No thicker than 6” cut in 4’ lengths put at the curb. Call Public Works at 522-4646 for chipping. If a private tree cutter is hired they are required to remove the debris.
- **BULK ITEMS** – Only one large item per collection (one couch, one dresser, one mattress, one box spring, etc.)
- **CAR PARTS** – Mufflers, batteries, etc. cannot be disposed of in the Trash Collection. Contact private contractor for removal or contact the MUA at 465-5004.
- **CAR TIRES (without rims)** – The City will pick tires up at a fee of \$5.00 per tire payable at City Clerk’s Office in City Hall.
- **CARPET** – Carpet from one room only at curb for collection and cut into 5’ widths, tied and rolled for pick-up. Not to exceed 50 lbs. **Installing new carpet – please have installer dispose of old carpet.
- **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS** – Arrangements must be made by homeowner with a private contractor for disposal. **DO NOT PLACE AT CURB.**
- **EXTRA LONG ITEMS** – If the item cannot fit into a container and under 50 pounds, it must be bundled and placed neatly curbside.
- **PAINT (CHEMICALS AND LIQUID COMPOUNDS)** – **NO LIQUIDS ACCEPTED.** Please call MUA at 465-5004 for their schedule of disposal times and limits. Paints can be opened and let dry to solid and collected as trash.
- **PLUMBING ITEMS** – Sinks, vanities, tubs, toilets, etc. must be removed by your plumbing contractor or private trash contractor. These items will not be picked up at all by the City Trash Contractor (can be disposed at the Woodbine Landfill).
- **ELECTRONICS** - TV’s, Computers, Microwaves, etc. may be brought to Recycle Center.
